



Statewide Probate Index

The Colorado State Archives is offering a program for volunteers to assist in providing a statewide probate index of Colorado probates from the 1860's to 1990's.

Goals:

- Complete project within 2 year timeframe
- Work with volunteers from across the state

Volunteer Information:

- Volunteers will work on computer terminals at the Colorado State Archives and on their personal computers to input data entry.
- Volunteers will receive one-on-one training through webinars or in-person.
- Data entry will be conducted on Wednesdays in volunteer area 1B20; hours will vary depending on schedule of volunteers.

Probate Information:

- The sources for the index will include original county and district court records consolidated from Colorado's 64 counties.

- For each probate, the index will include the name of the decedent, case number, year, county name, executor, whether a mental, conservatorship or guardianship, and location where the file exists.
